We work towards their academic progress in an inclusive, amicable environment.



We have maintained a high success rate of disbursing the different scholarships provided by the Central and State government:






Our students have conducted the Annual Status of Education Report (ASER), a survey on the status of primary education in rural West Bengal, in collaboration with Pratham Education Foundation.
