Both the parties named above agreed to abide by the terms and conditions detailed below under which the College and the NGO will work together.

1. College students/volunteers of the College accompanied by the faculty members will participate in the welfare programs organized by the NGO.
2. A group of 10 (ten) students will participate at a time.
3. The NGO will assist the College students in conducting welfare activities in a particular underdeveloped area of a village or a locality that is chosen as the work field by the College. Members of the NGO will always accompany the College students.
4. Programs to be undertaken will always be need based. Such programs chalked out by the NGO will only be finalized after consulting the College representative and/or faculty members or any other delegate recommended by the Principal/Teacher-in-charge.

A written approval from the Principal/Teacher-in-Charge will be forwarded to the NGO after which the students would join the program.

5. Community welfare programs of the following nature, when organized by the NGO, will include students from the College.
 - A. **Education for Children:** Free education and educational support/ guidance will be provided by the Staff (Teaching and non-teaching) and students stressing on Girl child.
 - B. **Health Check-up:** To be conducted by a qualified Doctor as arranged by the NGO with the assistance of Nursing Staff and Technicians. Students will undergo an orientation program by the NGO before joining such events.
 - C. **Nutrition and Health Education/Awareness:** Demonstration on low-cost nutritious foods and basic to moderate health Education will include-
 - I. Personal Hygiene
 - II. Completion of immunization schedule in case of children
 - III. Raising awareness on problems of early marriage.

- D. **Environmental Sanitation:** Students and NGO members will jointly approach civic authorities of the chosen field area (Panchayat office/ local govt. offices) in case of cleaning requirements, prevention from Malaria, etc. Tree plantation programs will be undertaken.
6. The NGO will inform the College Principal/Teacher-in-charge about the commencement of any of the above mentioned programs well ahead of time so students can get enough time for preparation.
 7. Safe and comfortable journey to and from the program site will be the responsibility of the College. Travelling expenses of the students for this purpose will be borne by the College.
 8. A letter from the Principal/Teacher-in-charge with the details of the participating students and the faculty members will reach the NGO office at least 7 (seven) days before the commencement of the program.
